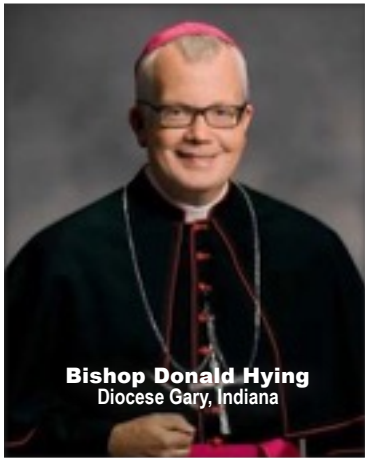

Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: Saturday, July 8th, 2017 - Travel day from Gary, Indiana, to the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help in Champion, Wisconsin: Bus departs from Gary, Indiana area. Meet your Pilgrimage Director when you board your motor-coach. Onboard program includes a video presentation of Our Lady of Good Help story, and a meditation on Our Lady. Upon arrival at the Shrine, the group will have a Rosary procession to the site of the apparitions. **Mass*** follows. Afterwards there will be time for Sacrament of Confession, personal devotion, and gift shop. Then continue on to Green Bay, Wisconsin, to enjoy a **group dinner**. Afterwards, transfer to your hotel for check-in. **(D)**

Day 2: Sunday, July 9th, 2017 - Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help and Green Bay: Start the day with a breakfast at the hotel. Upon arrival at the Shrine, proceed to the shrine's church for **Sunday Mass**. Afterwards, the group prays a **rosary**. There will be time for **Confession** and a reflection on board. Then join your fellow pilgrims for a tour of **Relevant Radio** (pending confirmation). The bus will make a panoramic drive of **Lambeau Field**. Our final meditation and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be prayed on-board as well as an inspirational movie onboard. **(B)**

General Terms & Conditions

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (you) acknowledges that Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. (d.b.a = doing business as Mater Dei Tours and Relevant Journeys) is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc., such as air transportation, hotel accommodations, ground and sea transportations, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Mater Dei Tours, Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc., Twin Cities Pilgrims and Relevant Radio and/or any religious or private organization contracting its services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions omissions, or conditions outside of their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks, and is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against them. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company, acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers.

Payments: For short motor-coach tours, full payment is required to secure your space. Make your check to Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. **Deposits will be refunded in the event the tour does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible.** If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due, Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. is authorized to charge the penalties to your credit card on record.

Tour Membership: To ensure a positive experience, the Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. reserves the right to reject any client whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be received in writing to our company prior to tour departure during normal business hours (9:00am to 5:00pm CST, Monday through Friday). All Cancellations are subject to the following per person penalties prior to departure:

- 60 days or prior \$50.00
- 59 to 45 days 50% of tour
- 44 to 35 days 75% of tour
- 34 to 0 days No Refunds

No refund can be made for non-refundable airfare.



Roommate Assignments: Landa Cleary Travel Inc. will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. Participants should expect to walk approximately 1 mile on the day of the event. Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Golf carts are available at the shrine to transport people up and down the hill. Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. is not responsible for denial of service by any of our suppliers.

Motor-coach Transportation and seating: We have selected a reputable and quality motor-coach line for this tour. Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions need to obtain Doctor's Orders so that there is proof of the condition to other passengers and may accommodate the order. Staff reserves the front row for ease with microphone use and driver communications when performing the tour/pilgrimage program. Seat rotation is requested each day so that all passengers get to enjoy different views from the coach.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. If international borders are crossed, we suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines involved (if any) because they may have additional requirements.

Voluntary changes to itinerary: Independent voluntary changes to an individual passenger's itinerary are usually not permitted by most of our tour suppliers. Some exceptions may be granted in a case-by-case basis.

Not Included: All items of a personal nature (room service, beverages, telephone charges, laundry, etc) and meals not specified on the tour itinerary are not included and must be paid by the passenger.

Accommodations and Itinerary: Land arrangements are provided as described in the tour program. The tour company reserves the right to change or substitute (1) hotels for accommodations in similar categories (2) or features of the itinerary in order to accommodate changes in the schedule.

Meals: Meals are provided as specified in the tour program. If you require special meals due to dietary restrictions, we must receive written details of your requirements at the time of booking.

Smoking: Smoking is not allowed on the motor-coach but frequent stops are made throughout the day.

Tips: No Gratuities are included unless they are part of the included itinerary. **Gratuities for Motor-coach Drivers are not included – please see your final documents for recommendations on tipping.**

Total Group Cancellation: If it becomes necessary to cancel an entire tour prior to departure (due to minimum quorums not being met or any unforeseen emergencies), Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. will offer the next available date or will make a full refund of

money paid. Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs or fees relating to such a tour booking or for any cancellation penalties due to non-refundable airfares, unless ticket is purchased as part of our negotiated group booking.
