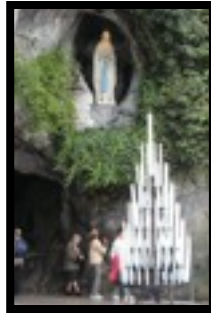

Day 1: Tuesday, September 25th, 2012: US Departure.

Meet your Mater Dei Tours representative at Chicago's O'Hare Airport (*Packaged airfare is available from Chicago, Illinois. Contact us for air transportation add-on costs from other cities*). Board your flight to France. (M)

Day 2: Wednesday, September 26th,

2012: Arrival in Lourdes, France: After a morning connection in Madrid, arrive in Toulouse, France, and transfer to **Lourdes Shrine**. Walk to the Lourdes Shrine for **Mass** in thanksgiving for a safe arrival. An orientation walk follows. Check into our hotel in Lourdes, relax and freshen up. Join your fellow pilgrims for a **welcome dinner** at our hotel. After dinner join pilgrims from around the world for the **Candle-light Rosary procession** at 9:00pm. (M, D)



Day 3: Thursday, September 27th, 2012:

Lourdes. Enjoy a special day in Lourdes. Begin with **Holy Mass** at the **Grotto (site of the apparitions** - Mass might be con-celebrated with other English speaking priests). Afterwards, you may opt for a personal day at leisure in Lourdes (time to go to the baths, participate in personal devotions, etc.) or you may want to follow your escorts on an informal **orientation walk** of the Lourdes of **St. Bernadette**, including sites like the **Mill**, where St. Bernadette was born, and the "**Cashot**", where Bernadette's family lived. Afternoon at your leisure with time to visit the grotto where St. Josemaria stopped to invoke Our Lady's protection and kissed the walls of the rock. At 5:00pm, there is a **Blessed Sacrament Procession** with **Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction**. After dinner join pilgrims from around the world for the **Candlelight Rosary Procession** at 9:00pm. (B, D)



Day 4: Friday, September 28th, 2012 (Feast of the Holy Archangels): Lourdes

& Torreciudad. Our memorable visit to Lourdes ends as we embark on an unforgettable journey that promises to be a visual feast, crossing the **Pyrenees Mountain Range**. Prepare your cameras as we ascend the **French Pyrenees** through small and picturesque ski resort villages encountered along the way. After crossing the border into Spain through the Bielsa tunnel, slowly descend through majestic sights of the **Aragonian Pyrenees**. Follow the current of the mountain waters until we arrive at **Torreciudad**, one of the most beautiful Marian Shrines in all of Spain. (Continued on next column)



Day 4: Friday, September 28th, 2012: (Continued)

Torreciudad. Travel through the spectacular landscape surrounding the sanctuary and the **Hermitage**, dating back to the Romanic times. Set above the clouds in the Aragonian Pyrenees, Torreciudad has been a local pilgrimage site for centuries. Upon arrival, there is a brief tour of Torreciudad, After the tour, there is a special program containing a meditation, the **Sacrament of Confession** and **Holy Mass**.



This afternoon drive to the nearby town of **Barbastro**, the **birthplace of St. Josemaría Escrivá**. Enjoy a relaxed stroll of this charming town, including a visit to its own Cathedral. Dinner awaits at the Lodge with a taste of one of the flavorful wines of Spain's **Somontano wine region**. (B,L,D)



Day 5: Saturday, September 29th, 2012: Torreciudad -

Logroño - Pilar (Zaragoza) - Torreciudad: After breakfast return to Torreciudad for Mass. Head west to the capital of the Rioja Wine Region, **Logroño**, the town where St. Josemaria received his vocation to the Priesthood. Enjoy a walking tour of this beautiful town. The building where the Escrivá's lived can still be seen near the famous "**Camino de Santiago**" (Road of St. James), one of the world's most famous pilgrimage routes. Afterwards, travel to **Zaragoza** (Saragossa), the Capital of Aragon. This is where St. Josemaria went to the Seminary. Our visit features the world famous Marian Shrine of the "**Basilica de Nuestra Señora del Pilar**" (Our Lady of the Pillar), where Our Blessed Mother appeared standing on top of a Pillar to the apostle **St. James**. It is reputed to be the first ever recorded apparition of Mary. This event happened while James was on his famous apostolic mission to Spain known as the "**Camino de Santiago**" (Road of St. James). In the massive **Plaza del Pilar** (Pilar Square), visit the chapel in the Basilica where the Pillar still stands. This is also the site of St. Josemaria's first Mass. As a sign of fulfillment of your pilgrimage to Our Lady of the Pillar, we will have the opportunity to practice the local custom of kissing the venerable column (or Pillar) where Our Lady once stood. Return to Torreciudad for our last night in Aragon. (B, D)

Day 6: Sunday, September 30th, 2012: Alcala de Henares and Madrid.

Before departing Torreciudad, fulfill the local pilgrimage tradition of kissing the medallion that once graced the very old statue of Our Lady of Torreciudad. Then travel from Aragon to Castille, and finally into the Community of Madrid. Stop in Alcala de Henares to visit the world famous **Talleres de Arte Granda**. Experience how talented artists design, create and restore sacred art as well as sacred vessels. Continue to Madrid, the great capital of Spain. Relax at our group dinner and enjoy a 4 night stay. (B, D)



Day 7: Monday: October 1st, 2012

(Feast of St. Therese of Lisieux): Madrid.

Enjoy a panoramic drive of Madrid's most famous sights like "Puerta de Alcalá", the "Gran Vía", Cibeles Fountain, the Royal Palace and the massive Cathedral of the "Almudena", dedicated to the Virgin Mary. The Cathedral has a beautiful chapel dedicated to St. Josemaria's devotion to Our Lady of Almudena. Then following St. Josemaria's footsteps, walk through some of Madrid's old streets where we find places unique to the history of Opus Dei and this Saint founder. During this walk we arrive at Plaza Mayor, the most famous square in Madrid, and nearby Plaza Mayor we find the Pontifical Basilica of St. Michael. This beautiful church is entrusted to the care of Opus Dei. Mass celebrated at the Cathedral or at St. Michael's. This afternoon enjoy a guided visit of what is popularly rated as the 3rd best collection of art in the world, the Museum of El Prado. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

Day 8: Tuesday, October 2nd, 2012 (Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels): Madrid: Feast Day of the Guardian Angels and the 84th Anniversary of the Foundation of Opus Dei in Madrid, where it all begun, back on October 2nd, 1928, Unless otherwise notified, the Mass will be at the Pontifical Basilica of St. Michael.

After the Mass, visit some of the corporate works of Opus Dei in Madrid. Afterwards, join us on a walk of several of the famous places frequented by St. Josemaria. Enjoy a panoramic tour driving by the different addresses and locations pertaining to St. Josemaria's life in Madrid and the early days of Opus Dei. Enjoy dinner with your group tonight. (B, D)



Day 9: Wednesday, October 3rd, 2012: Avila & Segovia:

Head north for the walled city of Avila, the land of St. Teresa de Jesus, the reformer of the Carmelite Order and first female Doctor of the Church. St. Josemaria had a lot of admiration for St. Teresa and shared her great devotion to St. Joseph. Visit the church of Our Lady of Sonsoles, site of St. Josemaria's 1935 Marian pilgrimage that started the family tradition of a Marian Pilgrimage during the month of May. Travel inside the medieval walls to enjoy an unforgettable walking tour of Avila featuring the life of St. Teresa. Before departing Avila visit the famous "Cuatro Postes" (four posts), a famous spot in the life of young St. Teresa and a great panoramic spot to take a picture of the city. Afterwards, depart for historic Segovia. With its imposing Alcazar Castle, ancient Roman aqueduct and historic Cathedral, Segovia is one of the most captivating cities in Castilla and one of UNESCO's patrimonies to humanity. St. Josemaria first used the image of the faithful donkey right here in Segovia after seeing a donkey pulling a mill wheel. End the visit at the church which houses the remains of St. John of the Cross, co-reformer of the Carmelite Order. Return to Madrid to enjoy our last dinner together sharing stories and memories of our time together. (B, D)

Day 10: Thursday, October 4th, 2012

(St. Francis of Assisi):

Madrid - Chicago,

Early morning transfer to Madrid's Barajas Airport.

General Terms & Conditions

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (you) acknowledges that Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. (d.b.a = doing business as Mater Dei Tours and Relevant Journeys) is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc., such as air transportation, hotel accommodations, ground and sea transportations, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. and any religious or private organization contracting its services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions omissions, or conditions outside their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks, and is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against them. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company, acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements of his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers.

Deposits: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure your space to Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. **Deposits will be refunded in the event the tour does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible.** If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due, Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. is authorized to charge the penalties to your credit card above.

Final Payments: Full payment must be made no later than **100 days** prior to departure unless otherwise stated. Payments may be made by check, Visa or MasterCard. If payment is not received as scheduled, your reservation may be automatically canceled and your deposit payment becomes forfeit. Tour Membership: To ensure a positive experience, the Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. reserves the right to reject any client whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be received in writing to our company prior to tour departure during normal business hours (9:00am to 5:00pm CST, Mondays through Fridays). All Cancellations are subject to the following per person penalties prior to departure:

- 95 days or prior \$300.00
- 94 to 65 days 50% of tour
- 64 to 35 days 75% of tour
- 34 to 0 days No Refunds

No refund can be made for non-refundable airfare.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. European coaches are usually not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. **Participants should expect to walk between 1 and in some cases 3 miles in one day.** Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Landa Cleary Travel Co., Inc. is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

Air Transportation: We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare or subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn frequent flier miles for group bookings.

Airline Seating: Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions need to obtain Doctor's Orders so the airlines have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. Passengers who desire a specific non-medical related seat are requested to contact the airline directly 30 days prior to departure for preferred seating.
