






MAP LEGEND:



Visit & Hotel Stay (# nights) Airplane Travel Motor-Coach Travel Contiguous Walking Trek

Day 1: Monday, July 24th: Depart USA. (M) Board your flight and relax onboard as you fly into European skies. (Group departs from Chicago. Other departure cities may be available for an add-on cost.).

Day 2: Tuesday, July 25th: Arrival in Lourdes, France.

(M,D) Clear European Immigration during our connection in Munich, Germany. After a short flight to Toulouse, France, we are processed through French Customs formalities. Then, follow your tour director to the "Groups Assembly Exit". After boarding

our coach, drive towards the Pyrenees to Lourdes, home of one of the world's most famous Marian Shrines, and the place where St. Bernadette saw and spoke with the Virgin Mary during several apparitions of the Immaculate Conception. After checkin, walk to the Shrine for Mass* in one of the Shrine's chapels. This evening, relax, freshen up, and join your group for dinner at our hotel.

Day 3: Wednesday, July 26th, 2023:

Lourdes, France. (B, D) Enjoy a special day in Lourdes. Begin with Holy Mass* at the grotto (site of the apparitions - Mass is usually con-celebrated with other English speaking priests). Afterwards, you may opt for a personal day at leisure in Lourdes (time to go to the baths, participate in personal devotions, etc.) or you may want to follow your escorts on an informal orientation walk of the was born and the "Cashot", where Bernadette's family lived. At 5:00pm, there is a Blessed Sacrament procession with Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction. Afterwards view a special video presentation in the main office. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. After dinner join pilgrims from around the world for the inspiring Rosary torch procession.

Day 4: Thursday, July 27th: Lourdes, Torreciudad,

Zaragoza. (B) Our memorable visit to Lourdes ends as we embark on an unforgettable journey that promises to be a visual feast, crossing the Pyrenees Mountain Range. Prepare your cameras as we ascend the French Pyrenees

through small and picturesque villages found along the way.

Day 4: Thursday, July 27th: Torreciudad, Zaragoza. [L, D (continued) ¡Hola España! After crossing the border into Spain, slowly descend through majestic sights of the Aragonian Pyrenees. Lunch will be provided in a local establishment in Barbastro located in the Somontano wine region. Follow the current of the mountain waters until we arrive at **Torreciudad**. arguably one of the most beautiful Marian Shrines in all of Spain. Travel through the spectacular landscape surrounding the sanctuary and the Hermitage, dating back to the 1100's. Set above the clouds in the Aragonian Pyrenees, Torreciudad has been a local pilgrimage site for centuries. Upon arrival, there is a tour of Torreciudad. After the tour, there is time for the Sacrament of Confession and Mass*. Then depart for Zaragoza, Spain, which features the world famous Marian Shrine, Basilica and Cathedral of Our Lady of the Pillar ["Basilica de Nuestra Señora del Pilar"]. This is where Our Blessed Mother appeared standing on top of a Pillar to the apostle St. James, the Greater [Santiago el Mayor]. It is reputed to be the first ever recorded apparition of Mary in the year 40 A.D. This evening, join your fellow pilgrims for a "Welcome to Aragon Casual **Dinner**" at a popular local restaurant. Evening at leisure in Zaragoza.

Day 5: Friday, July 28th: Aragon, Basque Country and

Rioja. (B. L*, D) Morning walk to the Basilica and Co-Cathedral of Our Lady of the Pillar to visit the chapel inside the Basilica where the Pillar still stands today. As a sign of fulfillment of your pilgrimage to Our Lady of the Pillar, we will have the opportunity to practice the local pilgrimage custom of kissing the venerable column (or Pillar) where Our Lady once stood. Mass* is celebrated Lourdes of St. Bernadette, including sites like the Mill, where St. Bernadette here in Spanish (most likely concelebrated with the Parish). Today we travel to Logroño, a city in Northern Aragon along the banks of the Ebro River. We disembark our coach prior to reaching the town and here we start our walk on the famous Camino de Santiago! Pass the Church of Santiago and the place where St. Josemaria was raised, as well as the place where he saw "the footprints in the snow" and received his vocation to the Priesthood. Then, proceed to the quaint, medieval Basque town where we visit a winery for lunch snacks and a wine tasting* tour. Afterwards, we walk some of the narrow streets overlooking the vineyards. With the Cantabrian mountains as a backdrop, we proceed to the edge of town where our motor coach awaits to transport us to the world famous Rioja Wine Region, where we find Santo Domingo de la

Calzada, a medieval town on the Camino, made famous by a saint who cared for pilgrims on the Way of St. James. If time allows, we once again walk a few final miles into town and check into our "Parador" hotel for dinner and a well-deserved rest.

Day 6: Saturday, July 29th: Santo Domingo to Burgos, Molinaseca to Ponferrada 🏌 (6.5 miles). (B. D) After breakfast we walk to Mass* at the Hermitage Church of Our Lady of the Plaza after which day of the final stretch of the Camino. we tour the local Cathedral of Santo Domingo de la Calzada, the site of the famous Camino Miracle of the Hen and the Rooster. Then, we pick up our motor-coach outside of town, and head west, tracing the Camino walk until we arrive at the amazing Cathedral of Burgos where we find the tomb of the great "El Cid". Proceed to Molinaseca, a small village on the Camino, where we start a walk to **Ponferrada**. In Ponferrada, we check into our hotel and enjoy dinner with our fellow pilgrims.

Day 7: Sunday, July 30th: Ponferrada to Sarria and Portomarín / (13.9 miles). (B, D) After breakfast, walk to the **Basilica de la Encina**. Mass* is celebrated here, right next door to the Knights Templar's Castle/Palace. After Mass, walk to our coach pick up point and proceed to Sarria, where we commence the final 100 kilometers of the Camino walk required to obtain the coveted "Certificate of Completion". Upon reaching Portomarín we depart for our hotel to check in and gather for dinner.



Day 8: Monday, July 31st: Portomarín to Palas del Rei 7 15.5 miles. (B, D) After breakfast we once again reconnect with the Camino. Our walk this morning will be a gradual climb through the village of Gonzar and then several quaint hamlet's (all with Castro in their names). The afternoon will be mostly even surface walking, passing through Portos and Lestedo on our way to Palas de Rei. Mass* either in the morning at a local church, or along the way on the Camino. At the end of the day return to our hotel for dinner and discussion of your experience with fellow pilgrims.

Day 9: Tuesday, August 1st: Palas del Rei to Arzúa // (17.9 miles). (B, D) After a good night's sleep and a hearty breakfast we embark on our 3rd full day of walking the Road of St. James. Although the longest of our walks, today's 17 miles covers a relatively easy terrain. Travel

through many small villages and cross a Roman bridge in Campanilla. Mass* celebrated either at a church in the morning or along the way on the Camino. At the end of a long day we check in to our hotel in Santiago de Compostela for the 1st of a 4-night stay. We retire after dinner preparing for the final 2 days of walking.



Day 10: Wednesday, August 2nd: Arzúa to O Pedrouzo 🎵

(11.9 miles). (B, D) After a good breakfast we are fueled to start the 1st Today, we leave Arzúa, walking through various hamlets on our way to O Pedrouzo. The terrain has some changes in altitude and the views are



breathtaking. The last part of the day we walk downhill and enter the town. The coach picks us up and takes us to our hotel for dinner and our 2nd-night stay. Mass* celebrated either in the morning at a

local church or along the way on the Camino.

Day 11: Thursday, August 3rd: Pedrouzo to Santiago de Compostela 郑 (12.4 miles). (B, D) After breakfast we begin our final walk passing by the Mount of Joy where we get our first glimpse of the imposing Cathedral from afar. We begin to anticipate our triumphant yet humble arrival at the world famous city of Santiago de Compostela, the resting place of St. James the Greater. This evening we once again enjoy dinner with our fellow pilgrims contemplating our visit to the Cathedral to complete our

pilgrimage within a pilgrimage. Mass* celebrated in the

Day 12: Friday, August 4th: Santiago de Compostela &

Fisterra. (B, D) Enjoy a delicious breakfast in preparation of our visit to the impressive Cathedral Basilica of St. James, with its immense censer locally called the "Botafumeiro"* (*operation of the Botafumeiro is not guaranteed) which requires several men to make it swing from end to end. Mass* will be celebrated here. Walk the town and enjoy the excitement of so many pilgrims that have completed their journey. Visit the Administration building and obtain your formal certificate, presenting your "Camino

Passport" with the many stamps you have earned along the way. This afternoon, if time allows, we take a special excursion to the town of Fisterra, where we find Cape Finisterre (Land's End). Here we exit the motor coach and walk the final scenic 2 miles to the lighthouse on the edge of the Eastern Shore of the Atlantic Ocean. After we have our fill of the cleansing ocean air and allow the rolling water and crashing waves to inspire us with the wonder of God's creation, we return to Santiago de Compostela for some well-deserved free time and our Farewell Dinner where we reminisce about the pilgrimage and share with each other the special events that touched us during this remarkable experience.







Day 13: Saturday, August 5th: Return to USA. (B) This morning depart for the airport in Porto, Portugal for your journey home, saying goodbye to Spain (and Portugal) but keeping the experience close to our hearts to share with family and friends as we arrive home.



Terms & Conditions

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (you) acknowledges that Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. (d.b.a. = doing business as Mater Dei Tours and Relevant Journeys) is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Mater Dei Tours, such as air transportation, hotel accommodations, ground and sea transportations, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Mater Dei Tours and any religious or private organization contracting it's services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions omissions, or conditions outside their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks, and is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against them. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the

Deposits: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure your space to Mater Dei Tours. Your deposits are used to cover and guarantee your space. Deposits will be refunded in the event the tour does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible. If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due. Mater Dei Tours is authorized to charge the penalties to the credit card listed on the registration.

Final Payments: Full payment must be made no later than 100 days prior to departure unless otherwise stated. Payments may be made by check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. If payment is not received as scheduled, your reservation may be automatically canceled and your deposit payment becomes forfeit. If you use a credit card as payment, for your convenience, you may opt to have Mater Dei Tours charge your balance to the same authorized credit card on the registration form by simply calling us with your verbal authorization.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be received in writing to our company prior to tour departure during normal business hours (9:00am to 5:00pm CST, Monday through Friday). Cancellations are subject to the following per person penalties prior to departure:

Tour Membership: To ensure a positive experience, Mater Dei Tours reserves the right to reject any client (before or during the trip at the expense of the traveler) whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. Participants should expect to walk at least 1 to 3 miles minimum in one day. Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

Roommate Assignments: Mater Dei Tours will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund. Mater Dei Tours cannot be held responsible if the roommate you were assigned to is not agreeable to you. If you desire to get your own room, you will be responsible for all the financial consequences of such action, including but not limited to, covering the single occupancy costs of both you and your ex-roommate.

Air Transportation: We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare and subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn, and/or upgrade with frequent flier miles for group bookings.

Airline Seating: Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions are advised to obtain Doctor's Orders so the airlines may have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. In addition to making the request through our company, please bring the doctor's note to the ticket counter. Passengers who desire a specific non-medical related seat are requested to contact the airline directly, approximately 30 days prior to departure for preferred seating. Group seating is under control of the airline and Mater Dei Tours can only pass on your requests.

Voluntary changes to itinerary: Independent voluntary changes to an individual passenger's itinerary are usually not permitted by most of our tour suppliers. Some exceptions may be granted in a case-by-case basis. All change requests must be made prior to 45 days before departure. If passenger purchased a land only package, they are free to plan their own itinerary before or after the trip (read Land Only bookings for restrictions).

Not Included: All items of a personal nature (room service, beverages, telephone charges, laundry, etc) and meals not specified on the tour itinerary are not included and must be paid by the passenger.

Accommodations and Itinerary: Land arrangements are provided as described in the tour program. The tour company reserves the right to change or substitute (1) hotels for accommodations in similar categories (2) or features of itinerary in order to accommodate changes in the schedule.

Meals: Meals are provided as specified in the tour program. If you require special meals due to medical dietary restrictions, we must receive written details of your requirements at the time of booking. We cannot guarantee that each and every vendor will honor your requested diet, but every effort will be made to report and accommodate these requests. No weight loss plans or special nutrition diets can be accommodated.

Passports: Obtaining a passport is the sole responsibility of the passenger. Passports must be current and valid beyond the dates of travel. Your airline ticket name must match your passport name or you may be denied boarding the airplane. Passengers who are denied boarding due to discrepancies between ticket and passport names or because of expired passports accept full responsibility and are subject to the cancellation terms of the tour. Some countries, such as Israel, require that your passport expiration be 6 months beyond your travel dates. We recommend that you apply for your passports (if needed) no later than 3 months before departure.

Tips: Gratuities for baggage, hotel and restaurants detailed in the itinerary are included. Gratuities for Tour Guide and Motor-coach Driver are NOT included (unless otherwise stated in the brochure). Please read your "Essential Reading Material" (provided with your documents) for recommendations on tipping Please budget accordingly.

Smoking: Smoking is not allowed on the motor-coach but frequent stops are made throughout the day.

Covid-19: This pilgrimage is being operated under the premise that it is safe to travel under the current Covid-19 situation. If governmental authorities and/or our tour vendors, declare that it is no longer safe to travel because of Covid-19 (or any other sickness). Mater Dei will need to cancel the pilgrimage. If all our vendors cancel their services, Mater Dei will issue a full refund to all. If a passenger cancels because of fear of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), but authorities still declare that it is safe to travel as long as people practice the appropriate advice to keep proper hygiene to avoid contamination, the passenger shall be assessed the appropriate cancellation penalty detailed in the first column. Please consider bringing a face mask (may be required by airlines and/or foreign governments), especially if you are coughing and sneezing). If you are sick with Covid-19, please stay home.

Total Group Cancellation: If it becomes necessary to cancel an entire tour prior to departure, Mater Dei Tours will offer the next available date or will make a full refund of money paid as soon as all our vendors refund us your money. Mater Dei Tours cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs, fees or cancellation penalties relating to any independent non-refundable purchases (personal airfares, travel insurance, etc.).
