

Day 01: Tuesday, January 9th, 2024: Depart U.S.A. (M) Depart United States for Tel Aviv. If flying with the group, your flight departs from Minneapolis/St. Paul with a connection. Departures from other cities may have an additional price.

Day 02: Wednesday, January 10th: Arrival in Tel Aviv. Caesarea Maritima, Mt. Carmel, Haifa and Nazareth (M, D) Arrive at Ben

Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. Clear Israeli immigrations and customs formalities and follow our director to the "Groups Assembly Exit" and meet our local staff. Depart for Caesarea Maritima, the old capital of the Roman Province of Palestina Prima. See Roman and Crusader ruins, along with the harbor from which St. Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. Continue on to Haifa where you'll visit Mount Carmel and the Cave of Elijah. Enjoy panoramic views of the Mediterranean Sea and Haifa City.

In the afternoon, visit Nazareth and the Basilica of the Annunciation where Holy Mass* is celebrated in a spirit of thanksgiving for a safe journey. After Mass, pray before the grotto where the **Annunciation** took place. Then, walk to the Church of St. Joseph's Workshop where men will consecrate their families to the head of the Holy Family. Transfer to your hotel in Galilee for a three-night stay. Relax at our welcome dinner as you acclimate to the Middle-Eastern time zone



Day 04: Friday, January 12th: Cana and locations around the Sea of Galilee. (B. L. D) After breakfast, travel to the site where Christ performed His first Miracle, Cana, where a surprise awaits for those married couples attending. Then proceed to the lake's

shore of the Sea of Galilee to visit the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount is remembered. Travel to Tabaha (with its famous ancient mosaic commemorating the miracle of the multiplication of loaves and fishes). Take a

memorable boat ride across the same lake Jesus walked, the Sea of Galilee (also known as the Lake of Genesareth or the Sea of Tiberias). A memorable **fish lunch** is planned (St. Peter's Fish). After lunch, continue on to the Church of Peter's Primacy (where Peter declares his love for Jesus three times). Continue on to Capernaum to see the ruins of the ancient synagogue and St. Peter's house. **Holy Mass*** requested in Cana. Return to your hotel for dinner.

Day 05: Saturday, January 13th; Jordan River, Jericho, & Bethlehem: (B, L, D) Departing Galilee and traveling down through the Jordan River Valley, we arrive at the real site of **Jesus' Baptism** by the Jordan River. Afterwards, drive to Jericho, by the excavations of the

oldest continuously inhabited city in the world. Visit the famous **Zacheus Tree** as well as the Good Shepherd Catholic parish and school where Holy Mass* is celebrated. Enjoy lunch at our favorite Christian restaurant in Jericho. Afterwards, view Mt. of Temptations where Jesus was tempted by the devil. End the day in **Bethlehem** at one of our favorite Christian owned hotels.

Day 06: Sunday, January 14th: Ein Karem, Shrine of the Book, Model of Jerusalem, Caves of Qumran, Dead Sea. (B, D) Drive to Ein Karem, to follow in the footsteps of the Blessed Virgin Mary when she visited her cousin, St. Elizabeth, the mystery of "The Visitation". Ein Karen is the birthplace of St. John the Baptist where Holy Mass* is celebrated. A rosary procession follows as we climb to the Church of the Visitation, site of one of Elizabeth and Zachariah's homes. Then travel to New Jerusalem, passing the Hebrew University and the Knesset, visit the Israeli Museum and the Shrine of the Book (Dead Sea Scrolls exhibit) and then to the 2nd Model of Old Jerusalem. Then travel east, down to the desert to visit the Qumran Caves (where the Essene enclave was) and see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were hidden. Finally, descend to the lowest point on Earth to dip in the therapeutic waters of the Dead Sea. Return to Bethlehem for dinner. Enjoy a leisure afternoon and evening. Return to hotel for dinner.

Day 07: Monday, January 15th: Bethlehem & Beit Sahour. (B, L, D) Start a wonderful day in Bethlehem and see the Church of the Nativity and below it, the cave-stable of Jesus' birth. Holy Mass* requested either at the cave where St. Jerome translated the bible into Latin or at the tomb of the Holy Innocents. Afterwards, walk to the nearby Milk Grotto, where tradition tells us that our Blessed Mother would retire to feed baby Jesus in privacy from the visitors. Learn about the miracle that occurred there, and the many subsequent miracles that followed! This afternoon, drive to the town of Beit Sahour where you'll find the

Shepherds' Fields, inhabited by Christians for hundreds of years. Afterwards, share lunch in the homes of local Christian families. You'll come to understand why the Church calls Holy Land Christians, "The Living Stones." This afternoon, we have shopping! Additional "surprise visits" available

if time allows. Return to your hotel for dinner.

Day 08: Tuesday, January 16th: Bethany, Mt of Olives, Gethsemane, Western Wall (Wailing Wall), Mt. Zion, Kidron Valley & Caiaphas' Palace. (B, D) This morning, drive up to the Mount of Olives for a wonderful view of Jerusalem. Visit Pater Noster Church, one of the sites where the "Our Father" prayer was taught as well as the Church's designated place of the Ascension. Walk the Palm Sunday

Way and stop at Dominus Flevit, the place where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. At the foot of the hill, see the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive trees and the Church of All Nations (with the rock where Jesus prayed in agony). Holy Mass* is celebrated here. Afterwards, visit the Wailing (or Western) Wall, the holiest site in Judaism, with views of the Al-Aksa Mosque and Dome of the Rock. Then visit the site known as David's memorial. Afterwards, visit the Caenaculum, the place where the Last Supper occurred as well as the Descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Walk to an overlook to see the Kidron Valley and the Pool of Siloam. Pray at St. Peter in Gallicantu (where St. Peter denied Jesus) built over the palace of Caiaphas, the High Priest. Enjoy dinner with your group tonight.

Day 09: Wednesday, January 17th: Old City of Jerusalem, Way of the Cross, Calvary & Holy Sepulchre, Pool of Bethesda, St. Ann Church, Confession & Adoration, The Man of the Shroud Exhibit. (B. D) Start the day very early, praying the Stations of the Cross, walking the true Way of the Cross (Via Dolorosa), ending up at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, where Jesus was crucified (Calvary) and buried, and then rose again. Continue with an unforgettable Mass* at the Tomb or in Calvary (pending confirmation). Return to the hotel for breakfast. Afterwards, pilgrims can choose to relax for the day, of join the group on a visit to the Pool of Bethesda, scene of Jesus' healing of the paralytic laying next to the wind-ruffled pool water. Afterwards, enter St. Ann's Church, with the best acoustics in any church in the Holy Land (our group can try singing). Then descend to the bottom of the church to pray a rosary at the traditional birthplace of the Virgin Mary. Travel to the Notre Dame center for Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions. In the same complex where Adoration and Confession is, pilgrims can visit an amazing one of a kind exhibit called "The Man of the Shroud" on their own.

Rest of the day at leisure to discover Old Jerusalem on your own. Return to your hotel for dinner with your group tonight

Day 10: Thursday, January 18th: Bethany, Road to Emmaus (Saxum Center), Our Lady Queen of Palestine. (B. This morning, visit **Bethany**, home of Lazarus, Martha & Mary, the place where Jesus enjoyed his good friends. Afterwards, drive on the road to Emmaus to visit the new Saxum Conference and Visitor Center where our staff reviews your pilgrimage up to that point, and you will learn the timeline of salvation history in a very unique manner. After the visit and touring is finished, there will be one last opportunity for confessions. Then, as a symbolic visit representing the 20th mystery of the Rosary (all locations of the Rosary Mysteries will be visited during this pilgrimage. except the Coronation of Mary, for obvious reasons), and as a crowning conclusion of our pilgrimage, we will visit the Shrine of Our Lady Queen of Palestine, housing the famous painting of Our Lady. There may be one last opportunity for religious articles shopping from the Little Sisters of Bethlehem who manage the shrine. Farewell Mass is celebrated at one of the locations visited today. Enjoy a memorable farewell dinner with your group!

Day 11: Friday, January 19th: Depart for USA. (B, M) After breakfast, transfer to Ben Gurion Airport to be processed for your return flight. Prepare to undergo top lengthy security before boarding. At your connection in Boston, you will be processed by U.S. Immigration and U.S. Customs. From there, connect to Minneapolis, St. Paul Airport.

Mater Dei Tours and any religious or private organization contracting it's services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions omissions, or conditions outside their control.

Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. Participants should expect to walk at least 1 to 3 miles minimum in one day. Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

Roommate Assignments: Mater Dei Tours will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund. Mater Dei Tours cannot be held responsible if the roommate you were assigned to is not agreeable to you. If you desire to get your own room, you will be responsible for all the financial consequences of such action, including but not limited to, covering the single occupancy costs of both you and your ex-roommate.

Air Transportation: We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare and subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn, and/or upgrade with frequent flier miles for group bookings.

Airline Seating: Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions are advised to obtain Doctor's Orders so the airlines may have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. In addition to making the request through our company, please bring the doctor's note to the ticket counter.
