# St. Peregrine's Italy

**NOTE:** Although a motor-coach is provided for some of the tours, it is important to point out that all Italian tours require a considerable amount of walking.

## Day 1 (Thursday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2026) US

**Departure:** **M** Depart the U.S. for **Florence**, and enjoy dinner, drinks and video entertainment onboard as you fly to the European continent. Airfare included from **Denver, CO** (Airfare may be available from other cities for an additional price. Please call for more information.). Meet Fr. Chris Krymski, O.S.M. (Chaplain) and Dennis Gaetano (Tour Director) at the airport.

## Day 2 (Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>) Arrive in

**Florence, Italy – Monte Scenario:** **M, D** Arrive in Florence's Peretolla airport, collect your luggage and board your Motor-coach for your travel to **Monte Senario**, the Birthplace of the Order of Servants of Mary. Visit the Monastery where a **Mass\*** of thanksgiving is celebrated for a safe arrival. Afterwards, return to **Florence**, the Capital of the Arts and cradle of the Renaissance. Check-in at your hotel for a 3 night stay. Tonight, enjoy a "welcome to Italy dinner."



## Day 3 (Saturday, October 24<sup>th</sup>) Florence: **B**

Start the day Enjoy a **walking tour of Florence** featuring visits to memorable places like "**Santa Maria dei Fiori**", commonly known as the **Duomo** (where **Mass\*** is celebrated), flanked by Giotto's Bell Tower and St. John's Baptistery; and **Museo Dell'Accademia (Academy Museum)**, where one of **Michelangelo's** most famous masterpieces can be found. The massive statue of **David** standing with his slingshot can be admired here along with an impressive collection of art. Stroll the **Signoria Square** filled with magnificent outdoor art and end the day at Basilica of the Holy Cross or **Santa Croce**, a Franciscan church containing the burial places of the most famous Florentines in history (Galileo Galilei, Dante, Machiavelli, Michelangelo and others). Afterwards, enjoy a leisure day, maybe taste a gelato by **Ponte Vecchio**. Dinner on your own this evening.



## Day 4 (Sunday,

**October 25<sup>th</sup>) Forli - San**

**Peregrino. B, D** After breakfast, travel to beautiful and ancient **Forli**, nestled between the Apennines and the Adriatic Coast. It is the birthplace of **St. Peregrine Laziosi** who was canonized 300 years ago and is known as the **Patron of Cancer Patients**. Visit the **Basilica di San Pellegrino Laziosi** where **Mass\*** is celebrated. This Basilica houses the relics of **St. Peregrine**, considered as one of the "**Incorruptibles**" Saints. Afterwards, we return to Florence and join your fellow pilgrims for dinner.



## DAY 5 (Monday, October 26<sup>th</sup>) Assisi: **B, D**

This morning, board your motor coach and say arrivederci to Florence and enjoy a relaxing drive to the peaceful Umbria region, the land of St. Francis and St. Clare. Arrive in lower **Assisi** to pray at the '**Porziuncula**' (the first Franciscan house), the **Transit Chapel** (where St. Francis died), and the **thornless rose garden**, all inside the stunning **St. Mary of the Angels Basilica**, where **Holy Mass\*** is celebrated. After this visit, travel to upper Assisi to check in at our hotel for a 2-night stay. Depending on time, we may commence the first part of the Upper Assisi tour today. Enjoy **dinner** in Assisi with your fellow pilgrims. Leisure time after dinner.

**DAY 6 (Tuesday, October 27<sup>th</sup>) Assisi: B, D** Enjoy a walking tour of Assisi including the Lower and Upper Basilicas of St. Francis filled with world famous Giotto frescoes that depict the lives of Jesus and St. Francis, as well as other saints. Visit the tombs of St. Francis and his disciples. Visit other important sights such as the place of St. Francis' birth, his home, also the Basilica di Santa Chiara where the remains of St. Clare can be found in its crypt. You will also be able to pray before the famous Cross of San Damiano in this Basilica (the Cross that spoke to St. Francis). In addition, our group will visit the church of Santa Maria Maggiore housing the remains of San Carlo Acutis. Holy Mass\* requested at the Tomb of St. Francis, St. Clare's Basilica, Santa Maria Maggiore, or one of the churches in Assisi. This afternoon, we depart for the Capital of Italy and ancient home of the greatest empire in western civilization, Roma. "Welcome to Roma" dinner tonight. Check-in at your 4-night stay hotel.

**Day 7 (Wednesday, October 28<sup>th</sup>)  
Papal Audience and Imperial Rome  
and St. Mary Major: B, D**

Join pilgrims from all over the world for a once in a lifetime experience, a General Audience with Pope Leo XIV at the Vatican (pending the Holy Father's schedule). After the Pope's message, the Holy Father will impart his blessing on you and your family (bring your personal religious articles – rosaries, etc... – as they will be blessed too). After the audience, travel to the historical center of Rome to enjoy a panoramic tour of Imperial Rome, including a walk around the famous Coliseum (Flavian Amphitheater) built in 72 AD, flanked on one side by the Arch of Constantine and surrounded by the impressive Roman Forum. A visit is also scheduled for the famous Mamertinum Prison (this is not a tour for the claustrophobic) where St. Peter and St. Paul were once chained. Our tour will also visit St. Peter in Chains, where Michelangelo's Moses can be found, as well as the Chains of Peter (the miracle of the fused chains of Jerusalem and Rome). Then from the coach, enjoy a panoramic views (subject to ever-changing local bus restrictions) the Vittorio Emanuel II monument ("wedding cake building" housing the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier) also known as the Altar of the Homeland, located in Piazza Venezia (next to the old Venice embassy building used by Mussolini to give his famous speeches). Afterwards, if time allows, visit St. Mary Major, commissioned in the year 360AD (approximately), and known as the first Basilica to be dedicated to the Virgin Mary (Our Lady of the Snows). The famous icon of Mary, Health of the Roman People, believed to have been written by St. Luke, can be found in the beautiful Cappella Paolina built by Paul V. The remains of St. Jerome are the relics below the main Altar, and in the confessional of the Altar are the remnants of Jesus' manger of Bethlehem. Enjoy dinner with your fellow pilgrims and return to your hotel for your second night in Rome.

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**DAY 8: (Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup>): Vaticano  
(St. Peter's & Vatican Museum) and  
Scavi\*. B**

Start the day with Holy Mass\* at St. Peter's Basilica. After Mass, enjoy a tour of the largest Church in the world, the Basilica di San Pietro (St. Peter's Basilica). There will be a chance to pay respects to Saint John Paul the Great at his tomb in the St. Sebastian Altar, and visit the Crypt of St. Peter – under the main church, where the remains of many Popes, including the first Pope lay. Afterwards, tour the impressive Museo Vaticano (Vatican Museum) with a fascinating collection of historical artifacts and precious objects of art, including the magnificent Cappella Sistina (Sistine Chapel) with the famous Michelangelo frescoes featuring the Last Judgment. After the tour, enjoy lunch with your fellow pilgrims at nearby restaurant.

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**DAY 8: (Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup>): Scavi Tour\*** (Continued on previous column)

After lunch, \*pending final approval from Vatican authorities, we shall journey below the crypt of St. Peter's Basilica into the amazing excavations known as **The Scavi\*\*** (this is not a tour for the claustrophobic). The Scavi was secretly excavated during World War II (to protect it from the Nazis) with the object of finding the tomb of St. Peter, the first Pope, which tradition always said was below the Basilica. Walk through an incredibly preserved ancient Roman necropolis. As the past comes alive, our tour guide shows the way through secret passageways which lead you to witness the most amazing conclusion underneath St. Peter's main Altar! "Upon this Rock I will build My Church". This exclusive voyage below St. Peter's will forever be a strong memory and confirmation of your Catholic Faith. \*\*The Scavi tour is pending confirmation and approval by St. Peter's Excavation office. Leisure evening in Rome follows.



**DAY 9: (Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup>): Roma  
Cristiana. B, D**

After breakfast, embark on an unforgettable excursion of the treasures of our faith. First, travel south down the 'Via Apia' (Apian Way) for a powerful journey experiencing how our early brothers and sisters survived and persevered in preserving our Lord's Church. Tour through an amazing complex of underground tunnels with an unending number of crypts, mausoleum tombs and chapels that fill every inch of every passageway that comprise the **Catacombs of St. Callixtus**. One of the highlights of this visit will be the place where the body of St. Cecilia was found. A very realistic statue that marks this place portrays the way her body laid, giving a final and resounding testimony to the Blessed Trinity at the time of her death. **Farewell Mass\*** is scheduled at the Catacombs complex. Continue on to the Basilica of **St. Paul Outside the Walls**, one of the 4 Patriarchal Basilicas of the Church. Although mostly rebuilt in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, this Basilica conserves the shape of the original St. Peter's Basilica. In addition to having portraits of every Pope, St. Paul Outside the Walls is most famous for housing the remains of the great **Apostle of the Gentiles, St. Paul**. Then visit 'Santa Croce in Gerusalemme' (Holy Cross of Jerusalem) where incredible relics can be found (fragments of the Holy Cross, one Nail, part of the inscription INRI, two thorns from the Crown of Thorns, fragments of the pillar of the scourging and of the rock of the Holy Sepulcher). Then walk down a lovely park to the 'Scala Sancta' (Holy Stairs) where you may climb the same steps Our Lord climbed on the way to see Pontius Pilate. We owe these beautiful relics, including the Holy Stairs, to St. Helena, the mother of Rome's first Christian Emperor, Constantine. Located across the street is **St. John Lateran**, another one of the Church's four major Basilicas and the **Cathedral of Rome** (Pope is the Bishop). Tonight, join your new pilgrim family for a memorable **Farewell Dinner**, reminiscing of all the wonderful times spent together.



**DAY 10: (Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup>): Return to USA B, M**

Transfer to Rome's Fiumicino Airport this morning for our flight home! As our airplane takes off, we take one last look at the beautiful land that now holds a special place in our hearts, and say:

**Arrivederci Italia! Welcome Home!**

Upon arrival in the USA, clear US Immigrations and Customs.

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (you) acknowledges that Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. (d.b.a. = doing business as Mater Dei Tours and St. Joseph Tours) is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Mater Dei Tours, such as air transportation, hotel accommodations, ground and sea transportations, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Mater Dei Tours and any religious or private organization contracting its services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions, omissions, or conditions outside their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks, and is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against them. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company, acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers.

**Deposits:** A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure a pilgrimage spot with Mater Dei Tours. Your deposits are used to cover and guarantee your space. **Deposits will be refunded in the event the tour does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible.** If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due, Mater Dei Tours is authorized to charge the penalties to the credit card listed on the registration.

**Final Payments:** Full payment must be made no later than the date stipulated below. Payments may be made by check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. If payment is not received as scheduled, your reservation may be automatically canceled and your deposit payment is forfeited. If you use a credit card as payment, for your convenience, you may opt to have Mater Dei Tours charge your balance to the same authorized credit card on the registration form by simply calling us with your verbal authorization.

**Cancellations:** All cancellations must be received in writing to our company prior to tour departure during normal business hours (9:00am to 5:00pm CST, Monday through Friday). All Cancellations are subject to the following per person penalties prior to departure:

If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due, Mater Dei Tours is authorized to charge the penalties to your credit card on record. Traveler agrees to forfeit their reserved space if payment is not made by the designated date. In the case of an approved refund, traveler agrees to forfeit 3% of all credit card charges to cover merchant fees originally absorbed by Mater Dei Tours.

**Tour Membership:** To ensure a positive experience, Mater Dei Tours reserves the right to reject any client (before or during the trip at the expense of the traveler) whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

**Travelers with Special Needs:** Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. **Participants should expect to walk at least 1 to 3 miles minimum in one day.** Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

**Young Travelers:** Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

**Roommate Assignments:** Mater Dei Tours will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund. Mater Dei Tours cannot be held responsible if the roommate you were assigned to is not agreeable to you. If you desire to get your own room, you will be responsible for all the financial consequences of such action, including but not limited to, covering the single occupancy costs of both you and your ex-roommate.

**Air Transportation:** We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare and subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn, and/or upgrade with frequent flier miles for group bookings.

**Airline Seating:** Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions are advised to bring Doctor's Orders to the counter so the airlines may have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. In addition to making the request through our company, please bring the doctor's note to the ticket counter. Passengers who desire a specific non-medical related seat are requested to contact the airline directly, approximately 30 days prior to departure for preferred seating. Group seating is under control of the airline and Mater Dei Tours can only pass on your requests.

**Voluntary changes to itinerary:** Independent voluntary changes to an individual passenger's itinerary are usually not permitted by most of our tour suppliers. Some exceptions may be granted in a case-by-case basis. All change requests must be made prior to 45 days before departure. If passenger purchased a land only package, they are free to plan their own itinerary before or after the trip (read Land Only bookings for restrictions).

**Not Included:** All items of a personal nature (room service, beverages, telephone charges, laundry, etc) and meals not specified on the tour itinerary are not included and must be paid by the passenger.

**Accommodations and Itinerary:** Land arrangements are provided as described in the tour program. The tour company reserves the right to change or substitute (1) hotels for accommodations in similar categories (2) or features of the itinerary in order to accommodate changes in the schedule.

**Meals:** Meals are provided as specified in the tour program. If you require special meals due to medical dietary restrictions, we must receive written details of your requirements at the time of booking. We cannot guarantee that each and every vendor will honor your requested diet, but every effort will be made to report and accommodate these requests. No weight loss plans or special nutrition diets can be accommodated.

**Passports:** Obtaining a passport is the sole responsibility of the passenger. Passports must be current and valid beyond the dates of travel (except for Mexico, where your passport needs to be valid just for the dates of travel). **Your airline ticket name must match your passport name or you may be denied boarding the airplane.** Passengers who are denied boarding due to discrepancies between ticket and passport names or because of expired passports accept full responsibility and are subject to the cancellation terms of the tour. Some countries (like Israel) require your passport expiration to be 6 months beyond your travel dates. **We recommend that you apply for your passports (if needed) at the time of registration, but no later than 3 months before departure (using expedited service).**

**Tips:** Gratuities for baggage, hotel and restaurants detailed in the itinerary are included. **Gratuities for Tour Guide and Motor-coach Driver are NOT included** (unless otherwise stated in the brochure). Please read your "Essential Reading Material" (provided with your travel documents) for recommendations on tipping. (usually \$17 USD per person, per day). Please budget accordingly.

**Smoking:** Smoking is not allowed on the motor-coach but frequent stops are made throughout the day.

**Travel Health:** This pilgrimage is being operated under the premise that it is safe to travel under the current health protocols. If competent authorities and/or our tour vendors, declare that it is no longer safe to travel because of any sickness, Mater Dei will need to cancel the pilgrimage. If all our vendors cancel their services, Mater Dei will issue a full refund to all. If a passenger cancels because of fear of a sickness, but authorities still declare that it is safe to travel as long as people practice the appropriate advice to avoid contamination, the passenger shall be assessed the appropriate cancellation penalty detailed in the first column. Please consider bringing a face mask (may be required by some airlines and/or foreign governments if you are sick), especially if you are coughing and sneezing. If you are sick with any kind of contagious virus or disease, please stay home.

**Total Group Cancellation:** If it becomes necessary to cancel an entire tour prior to departure, Mater Dei Tours will offer the next available date or will make a full refund of money paid as soon as all our vendors refund us your money. Mater Dei Tours cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs, fees or cancellation penalties relating to any independent non-refundable purchases (personal airfares, travel insurance, etc.). If you use a credit card as payment, traveler agrees to forfeit 3% of all credit card charges to cover merchant fees absorbed by Mater Dei Tours.

**Land Only Bookings:** Passenger(s) who desire to book their own airfare do so at their own risk. Land only passengers are responsible for connecting with the group at the hotel. Passenger(s) accept all responsibility for costs incurred due to misconnections with the group. Mater Dei Tours cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs or fees related to such a booking or for any cancellation penalties due to independent non-refundable airfare (even if Mater Dei Tours assisted with this booking).

**Luggage:** Your luggage may be handled by the bus driver and any assistants from hotel personnel; however, most hotels in Europe are eliminating the services of bell captains. Train tickets do not include portage. Luggage is carried at owner's risk throughout the tour (insurance suggested). Checked, carry-on and hand baggage and small articles such as coats, umbrellas or cameras are entirely in the care of the passenger. Size and weight limitations for carry-on and checked baggage vary from airline to airline and even according to destination, and are becoming more restrictive. Airlines with domestic connections reserve the right to charge airline baggage fees. Many international flights are now charging airline baggage fees. Check your final documents for details of acceptable luggage, fees, dimensions and weight allowed on your tour. **All baggage and personal effects are at all times and in all circumstances at the risk of the passenger. Baggage insurance is recommended** (see Travel insurance section below).

**Validity:** Rates in this brochure are valid for the travel period stated on the brochure, and are quoted on a per person sharing twin/double room basis. All prices are shown in U.S. Dollars and are calculated on currency rates and fares existing on the day the brochure was made.
