

Dav 1: Tuesdav. September 5. 2023: Departure Dav. Depart Chicago's O'Hare on our non-stop flight to Dublin. Relax onboard as you fly into Irish skies. (M)

Day 2: Wednesday, September 6: Drogheda, Hill of Slane,

Monasterboyce, Downpatrick (D) Arrive in Dublin early and travel north along some of Ireland's oldest inhabited areas. Arrive at St. Peter's Church in Drogheda where the relics of St. Oliver Plunkett can be found. Mass\* is celebrated here. Continue north to Monasterboyce, a monastery founded by St. Buithe, who died in 521. The name Monasterboyce is a partanglicization of the Irish name Mainistir Bhuithe, meaning "monastery of Buithe". In Monasterboyce you will find the finest Celtic Cross in Ireland. Our next stop on our morning excursion is one of the most historic sites of Ireland's Catholic Faith, the Hill of Slane. This is the place where tradition tells us that St. Patrick, after having lit a fire during the pagan "night of darkness" (same night as the Easter Vigil), at great risk, evangelized the natives and their king regarding the Blessed Trinity, using a simple shamrock as the means for their conversion. Then continue to Northern Ireland to visit the reputed site of St. Patrick's Tomb in Downpatrick, which is also the site that houses the remains of St. Bridget and St. Columba. Afterwards, travel to Belfast, Capital of Northern Ireland for our first of two nights stay. Mass\* at St. Peter's Church in Drogheda.



Day 3: Thursday, September 7: Belfast & Giant's Causeway. (E, D) Start the day with Mass at a local parish. Then a brief sightseeing drive of the beautiful Georgian City of Belfast. Next, we drive to the north

coast of Ireland to explore the impressive Giant's Causeway!

Thousands of huge octagonal columns, formed over 60 million years ago, create a dramatic coastline that disappears under water only to appear again in Scotland. The huge rocks have given rise to many legends, especially those involving Finn McCool, the famous giant from Ireland. Upon return to Belfast, visit the largest exhibit on the RMS Titanic, the famous ship built in Belfast.

Day 4: Friday, September 8 (Mary's Birthday): Armagh & Knock

(B, D) Visit the imposing Cathedral of Armagh, seat of the Archbishop Primate of Ireland. Construction of St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Cathedral began in 1840, but because of the intervening famine years, was not completed until 1873. The Cathedral is an imposing site, perched on the hilltop in Armagh and dominating its skyline. The church was designed and built in Neo Gothic style from pale limestone, with large twin spires. Then travel west to County Sligo. Visit Tobernalt to where we pray a Chaplet of Divine Mercy at the famous Mass Rock, where Priests celebrated Mass secretly during the times of the persecutions. Local tradition tells us that St. Patrick himself was here, and left a hand print on the old altar. This place is of great importance for the defense of the freedom to worship and a

commemoration for all those who

persevered in practicing their Faith in times of persecution, even if it meant endangering their lives. Afterwards, drive south west to one of the highlights of our pilgrimage, the famous Marian Shrine of Knock, where the Virgin Mary appeared to 15 people on

August 21, 1879. Rosary is prayed at the site of the apparitions. Arrive at our hotel in Knock (hotel may be in another town in County Mayo), and check-in for our 2-night stay. Mass\* to be celebrated at Armagh, Tobernalt or Knock.

## Day 5: Saturday, September 9: Knock Shrine. [3]

After your full Irish breakfast, enjoy a full day at the Marian Shrine of Knock. There we will pray a rosary while we walk around the shrine. Confessions follow and free time to explore the shrine's different areas like the Way of the Cross, the large Basilica, the old

church, the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel, and the shrine's gift shop. Enjoy an evening at leisure. Mass\* at the Apparition site, Basilica or Old church.

Day 6: Sunday, September 10: Westport, Croagh Patrick, Kylemore Abbey, Galway. (E, D) Start the day traveling west to County Mayo on a panoramic drive to see Westport, the largest emigration port city on the northern half of Ireland. Travel to Croagh Patrick, where St. Patrick stayed for 40 days of penance, claiming for Christianity the tall mountain that was once dedicated to a pagan god. See beautiful views of the Clew Bay and the Atlantic. After a symbolic climb (only a partial climb) praying the rosary, travel through the northern part of the Connemara National Park to see Kylemore Abbey, a magnificent historic mansion nestled in the woods, now belonging to the Benedictine nuns. From there, continue through the Connemara region and admire the sweeping views of boglands and misty mountains. As you drive along you will see many sheep that graze freely and also tracts of bogland where some people hand-cut peat for home heating. Drive by Connemara's most

beautiful but saddest road, the "Famine Way", where we stop to pray by the Monument to the Famine, and learn about one of the greatest suffering times of the Irish people. End your day at your hotel located in the rugged Connemara Coast of County Galway. Join your fellow pilgrims for dinner. Mass\* requested at Kylemore Chapel.



Day 7: Monday, September 11: Cong, Corrib Cruise\*, Galway City. (E) Depart for Cong, a small village made famous for being the place where the famous movie "The Quiet Man" (Maureen O'Hara and John



Wayne) was filmed. Visit the ruins of **Cong Abbey** by the river. After your visit to Cong, pending on weather, availability and time, we may take a **cruise on Lake Corrib**. Afterwards, continue to one of Ireland's most charming cities! **Galway City** has a unique festive atmosphere with lots of culture and heritage, overlooking Galway Bay. Explore old Galway where the balance of the day is at leisure for independent activities and dining.

Eyre Square forms the hub of the city and contains the John F. Kennedy Memorial Park, where you can sit and people-watch. Many of the narrow streets, such as Shop Street, are pedestrianized and contain shops, pubs and teashops. Lynch's Castle dates from 1320, but is now a bank where portions of the medieval walls are still visible



along Eyre Square. Enjoy a stroll along the rushing River Corrib, which links lake Corrib to Galway Bay. There is an abundance of eating and entertainment options! Galway City is famous for live folk music which streams out of every pub. Evening at leisure in Galway City. Mass\* celebrated at St. Mary of the Rosary in Cong.

#### Day 8: Tuesday, September 12: County Clare & County Kerry. (B, D)

After Mass\*, drive around **Galway Bay** and pass through the **Burren Country**, an area of rocky limestone hills where a number of unique flowers thrive. This region also contains many dolmens, prehistoric monuments formed by large limestone slabs. Drive along the coastline of County Clare to view the **Cliffs of Moher**, one of the

country's most magnificent rock formations that rise to heights of almost 700 feet above the churning Atlantic swells. Afterwards **cross the Shannon Estuary** in a **ferry** and arrive in Tarbert. Continue the drive south until our arrival in **Tralee** (famous for the Rose of Tralee), one of the lively towns in County Kerry. After checking into your hotel. This

evening, join your fellow travelers for dinner. **Mass**\* concelebrated at Galway Cathedral.



**Day 9: Wednesday, September 13: Ring of Kerry, Killarney.** (E) Today admire breathtaking vistas of mountains, cliffs and beaches on Ireland's most popular drive, **The Ring of Kerry**. See a variety of natural beauty as you drive 100 miles around this scenic route. A number of stops will allow you to admire the spectacular scenery. Head back to Killarney through **Moll's Gap** with stunning views of the **Lakes of Killarney.** Then travel to **Tralee**, widely celebrated for its famous song. Enjoy an evening of dining and leisure on your own tonight. **Mass\* at St. Johns Parish** in Tralee, considered to be one of the most beautiful gothic revival churches in Ireland.

#### Day 10: Thursday, September 14: Tipperary & Dublin. (B, D)

Say good-bye to County Kerry this morning and travel to the fertile **County Tipperary** to visit the impressive "**Rock of Cashel**" Castle, seat of the High Kings of Ireland. Afterwards, travel to the richly

historical Capital of Ireland, **Dublin.** After check-in, enjoy dinner with the group. **Mass\*** to be celebrated at either St. John the Baptist Church in Cashel, or at St. Mary's Pro-Cathedral in Dublin.



# Day 11: Friday, September 15:

**Dublin.** (B, D) Start the day with a panoramic drive of Dublin City, featuring views of St. Patrick's Cathedral, Christchurch Cathedral, Dublin Castle, O'Connell Street, the Post Office (site of the 1916 Rebellion), River Liffey, the Half Penny Bridge, Grafton Street and St. Stephen's Green. Stop by **St. James Gate** to get acquainted with Ireland's most famous beverage, **Guinness.** Afterwards, we visit **White Friars Church** to pray before the relics of St. Valentine, and it's here too where the group celebrates its Farewell **Mass\***. Enjoy a memorable and **festive farewell dinner** with all your fellow pilgrims.

### Day 12: Saturday, September 16, 2022: Return to USA. (B, M)

Transfer to **Dublin Airport** for check-in as well as US Immigration and Customs which is processed in Ireland. Board your non-stop flight from Dublin to Chicago. Relax as you return to the USA.

# Terms & Conditions - IRELAND

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (you) acknowledges that Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. (d.b.a. = doing business as Mater Dei Tours and Relevant Journeys) is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Mater Dei Tours, such as air transportation, hotel accommodations, ground and sea transportations, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Mater Dei Tours and any religious or private organization contracting it's services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions omissions, or conditions outside their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks, and is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against them. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company, acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers

Deposits: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure your space to Mater Dei Tours. Your deposits are used to cover and guarantee your space. Deposits will be refunded in the event the tour does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible. If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due. Mater Dei Tours is authorized to charge the penalties to the credit card listed on the registration.

Final Payments: Full payment must be made no later than 100 days prior to departure unless otherwise stated. Payments may be made by check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. If payment is not received as scheduled, your reservation may be automatically canceled and your deposit payment becomes forfeit. If you use a credit card as payment, for your convenience, you may opt to have Mater Dei Tours charge your balance to the same authorized credit card on the registration form by simply calling us with your verbal authorization.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be received in writing to our company prior to tour departure during normal business hours (9:00am to 5:00pm CST, Monday through Friday). All Cancellations are subject to the following per person penalties prior to departure:

Tour Membership: To ensure a positive experience, Mater Dei Tours reserves the right to reject any client (before or during the trip at the expense of the traveler) whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. Participants should expect to walk at least 1 to 3 miles minimum in one day. Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

Roommate Assignments: Mater Dei Tours will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund. Mater Dei Tours cannot be held responsible if the roommate you were assigned to is not agreeable to you. If you desire to get your own room, you will be responsible for all the financial consequences of such action, including but not limited to, covering the single occupancy costs of both you and your ex-roommate.

Air Transportation: We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare and subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn, and/or upgrade with frequent flier miles for group bookings.

Airline Seating: Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions are advised to obtain Doctor's Orders so the airlines may have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. In addition to making the request through our company, please bring the doctor's note to the ticket counter. Passengers who desire a specific non-medical related seat are requested to contact the airline directly, approximately 30 days prior to departure for preferred seating. Group seating is under control of the airline and Mater Dei Tours can only pass on your requests.

Voluntary changes to itinerary: Independent voluntary changes to an individual passenger's itinerary are usually not permitted by most of our tour suppliers. Some exceptions may be granted in a case-by-case basis. All change requests must be made prior to 45 days before departure. If passenger purchased a land only package, they are free to plan their own itinerary before or after the trip (read Land Only bookings for restrictions).

Not Included: All items of a personal nature (room service, beverages, telephone charges, laundry, etc) and meals not specified on the tour itinerary are not included and must be paid by the passenger.

Accommodations and Itinerary: Land arrangements are provided as described in the tour program. The tour company reserves the right to change or substitute (1) hotels for accommodations in similar categories (2) or features of the itinerary in order to accommodate changes in the schedule.

Meals: Meals are provided as specified in the tour program. If you require special meals due to medical dietary restrictions, we must receive written details of your requirements at the time of booking. We cannot guarantee that each and every vendor will honor your requested diet, but every effort will be made to report and accommodate these requests. No weight loss plans or special nutrition diets can be accommodated.

Passports: Obtaining a passport is the sole responsibility of the passenger. Passports must be current and valid beyond the dates of travel. Your airline ticket name must match your passport name or you may be denied boarding the airplane. Passengers who are denied boarding due to discrepancies between ticket and passport names or because of expired passports accept full responsibility and are subject to the cancellation terms of the tour. Some countries, such as Israel, require that your passport expiration be 6 months beyond your travel dates. We recommend that you apply for your passports (if needed) no later than 3 months before departure.

Tips: Gratuities for baggage, hotel and restaurants detailed in the itinerary are included. Gratuities for Tour Guide and Motor-coach Driver are NOT included (unless otherwise stated in the brochure). Please read your "Essential Reading Material" (provided with your documents) for recommendations on tipping Please budget accordingly.

Smoking: Smoking is not allowed on the motor-coach but frequent stops are made throughout the day.

Covid-19: This pilgrimage is being operated under the premise that it is safe to travel under the current Covid-19 situation. If governmental authorities and/or our tour vendors, declare that it is no longer safe to travel because of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), Mater Dei will need to cancel the pilgrimage. If all our vendors cancel their services, Mater Dei will issue a full refund to all. If a passenger cancels because of fear of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), but authorities still declare that it is safe to travel as long as people practice the appropriate advice to keep proper hygiene to avoid contamination, the passenger shall be assessed the appropriate cancellation penalty detailed in the first column. Please consider bringing a face mask (may be required by airlines and/or foreign governments), especially if you are coughing and sneezing). If you are sick with Covid-19, please stay home.

Total Group Cancellation: If it becomes necessary to cancel an entire tour prior to departure, Mater Dei Tours will offer the next available date or will make a full refund of money paid as soon as all our vendors refund us your money. Mater Dei Tours cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs, fees or cancellation penalties relating to any independent non-refundable purchases (personal airfares, travel insurance, etc.).
