Day 01: Monday, June 12th 2023: Depart U.S.A. (M)

Depart United States for Tel Aviv via United Airlines. If flying with the group, your flight departs either from Pittsburgh or Chicago O'Hare Airport. Departures from other cities may incur an additional price.

Day 02: Tuesday, June 13th: Arrival in Tel Aviv. (M, D) Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. Clear Israeli immigrations and customs formalities and follow our director to the "Groups Assembly Exit" and meet our local staff. Transfer to your hotel in Galilee for a four-night stay. Relax at our welcome dinner as you acclimate to the Middle-Eastern time zone.

Day 03: Wednesday, June 14th: Caesarea Maritima, Mt. Carmel, Haifa and Nazareth. (B, D) Visit Nazareth and the Basilica of the Annunciation where Holy Mass* is celebrated. After Mass, pray before the grotto where the Annunciation took place. Then, walk to the Church of St. Joseph's Workshop where men will consecrate their families to the head of the Holy Family. Return to your hotel for

dinner, Depart for Caesarea Maritima, the old capital of the Roman Province of Palestina Prima. See Roman and Crusader ruins, along with the harbor from Caesarea Philippi which St. Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. Continue on to Haifa where you'll visit Mount Carmel and the Cave of Elijah. Enjoy panoramic views of the Mediterranean Sea and Haifa City.

Day 04: Thursday, June 15th: Cana, Caesarea Philippi & Mt. Tabor. (B, D) Begin the day by traveling to where Jesus performed His first Miracle, Cana (Holy Mass* requested here), where a surprise awaits for those married couples attending. Then journey north for an unforgettable visit to beautiful Caesarea Philippi, where Peter proclaimed Christ as the Son of God and received the Keys to the Kingdom. Following in the footsteps of Jesus and the Apostles, travel to Mt. Tabor, site of the Transfiguration of Jesus. Experience the views from where Peter, James and John saw the Glorified Lord with Moses and Elijah. Time permitting, our staff will have some surprise visits planned for you. Afterwards, return to your hotel for dinner.

Day 05: Friday, June 16th: Locations around the Sea of Galilee. (B, L, D) After breakfast, travel to the lake's shore of the Sea of Galilee to visit the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount is remembered. Travel to Tabgha (with its famous ancient mosaic commemorating the miracle of the multiplication of loaves and fishes). Take a memorable boat ride across the same lake Jesus walked, the Sea of Galilee (also known as the Lake of Genesareth or the Sea of Tiberias). A



memorable **fish lunch** is planned (St. Peter's Fish). After lunch, continue on to the Church of Peter's Primacy (where Peter declares his love for Jesus three times). Continue on to Capernaum to see the ruins of the ancient synagogue and St. Peter's house. Holy Mass* celebrated in Capernaum. Return to your hotel for dinner.

Day 06: Saturday, June 17th: Jordan River, Jericho, & Bethlehem: (B, D) Depart Galilee, and traveling down through the Jordan River Valley, we arrive at the real site of Jesus' Baptism by the Jordan River. Afterwards, drive to Jericho, the oldest continuously inhabited city in the world. See the famous Zacheus Tree and visit the Good Shepherd Catholic parish and school where Holy Mass* is celebrated. Afterwards, view Mt. of Temptations where Jesus was

tempted by the devil. End the day in **Bethlehem** at one of our favorite Christian owned hotels.


Day 07: Sunday, June 18th: Ein Karem, The Visitation & Birth of St. John the Baptist & Western "Wailing" Wall. (B.D) Drive to Ein Karem, to follow in the footsteps of the Blessed Virgin Mary when she visited her cousin, St. Elizabeth, during the mystery of "The Visitation". Ein Karen is the birthplace of John the Baptist where Holy Mass* is celebrated. A rosary procession follows as we climb to the Church of the Visitation, site of one of Elizabeth and Zachariah's homes. If time allows, stop at the house of St. Marie Alphonsine, founder of the Sisters of the Rosary, and one of the two recently canonized Palestinian Saints. Then visit the Wailing (or Western) Wall, holiest site in Judaism, with views of the Al-Aksa Mosque and Dome of the Rock.. As we return to our hotel, if time allows, our group will enter a Carmelite Monastery housing the relics of their foundress, St. Miriam of Jesus Crucified, the other Palestinian Saint canonized in May 2015. Afterwards, return to your hotel for dinner.



Day 08: Monday, June 19th: Bethlehem and Beit Sahour. (B, L, D) Start a wonderful day in Bethlehem by visiting the Church of the Nativity, where below its main Altar, lies the cave-stable of Jesus' birth. Holy Mass* requested either at the cave where St. Jerome translated the bible into Latin or at the tomb of the Holy Innocents. Afterwards, walk to the nearby Milk Grotto, where tradition tells us that our Blessed Mother would retire to feed baby Jesus in privacy from the visitors. Learn about the miracle that occurred there, and the many subsequent miracles that followed! This afternoon, share lunch in the homes of local Christian families. You'll come to understand why the Church calls Holy Land Christians, "The Living Stones". Then drive to the town of Beit Sahour where you'll find the Shepherds' Fields, inhabited by Christians for hundreds of years. Return to your hotel for dinner.

> Day 09: Tuesday, June 20th: New Jerusalem, Israeli Museum: Dead Sea Scrolls & Jerusalem Model, Bethany,

Qumran Caves and Dead Sea. (B, D) After morning Mass* in Bethlehem, drive to modern Jerusalem, passing the Hebrew University and the Knesset, visit the Israeli Museum and the Shrine of the Book (Dead Sea Scrolls exhibit) and then to the amazing 2nd Model of Old Jerusalem. Then visit Bethany, home of Lazarus, Martha & Mary, the place where Jesus enjoyed his good friends (Mass* celebrated here).

Afterwards, travel east to visit Qumran (where the Essene enclave was) and see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were hidden. Finally, descend to the lowest point on Earth to dip in the therapeutic waters of the **Dead Sea**. Return to Bethlehem for dinner.



Did you know?

The Dead Sea is known for its therapeutic waters. It is the lowest point on Earth (1,348 ft)! When we travel from the Dead Sea to Jerusalem we actually climb 3,865

Day 10: Wednesday, June 21st: Mt of Olives, Gethsemane, Betrayal Cave, Mt. Zion, Kidron Valley & Caiaphas' Palace. (B, D) This morning, drive up to the Mount of Olives for a

wonderful view of Jerusalem. Visit Pater Noster Church, one of the sites where the "Our Father" prayer was taught as well as the Church's designated place of the Ascension. Walk the Palm Friday

Way and stop at Dominus Flevit, the place where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. At the foot of the hill, see the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive trees and the Church of All Nations (with the rock where Jesus prayed in agony). Holy Mass* is celebrated here. See the site known as David's memorial and then visit the Caenaculum, the place where the Last Supper occurred as well as the Descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Walk closer to the Kidron Valley and see the Pool of Siloam, and St. Peter in Gallicantu (where St. Peter denied Jesus) built over the palace of Caiaphas, the High Priest. Return to your hotel to

enjoy dinner with your group. Day 11: Thursday, June 22nd: Old City of Jerusalem, Calvary & Holy Sepulchre, The Man of the Shroud **Exhibit**. (B, D) Start the day very early, praying the Stations of the Cross, walking the true Way of the Cross (Via Dolorosa), ending up at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, where Jesus was crucified (Calvary) and buried, and then rose again (Holy Sepulchre). Continue with an unforgettable Mass* at the Tomb or in Calvary (pending confirmation). Return to our hotel for breakfast and a break. Later on, visit the Pool of Bethesda, scene of Jesus' healing the paralytic next to the wind-ruffled pool water. Afterwards, enter St. Ann's Church (best acoustics in any Holy Land church) to pray at the birthplace of the Virgin Mary. End the day with an amazing one of a kind self quided exhibit called "The Man of the Shroud". Today there may be an

opportunity for Adoration and Confessions.

Day 12: Friday, June 23rd: St. Ann, Bethesda Pool, Road to Emmaus, Saxum Center. (B, D) Today, visit the Pool of Bethesda, scene of Jesus' healing the paralytic next to the wind-ruffled pool water. Afterwards, enter St. Ann's Church (best acoustics in any Holy Land church) to pray at the birthplace of the Virgin Mary. Later on, drive on the road to Emmaus to visit the new Saxum Conference and Visitor Center where our staff reviews your pilgrimage up to that point. After the

tour is finished, there will be another opportunity for confessions. Farewell Mass is celebrated here. Then, as a symbolic visit representing the 20th mystery of the Rosary (all Rosary Mysteries locations will be visited except the Coronation of Mary), and as a crowning conclusion of our pilgrimage, we will visit the Shrine of Our Lady Queen of Palestine, housing the famous painting of Our Lady. This evening, enjoy a memorable farewell dinner with your group tonight! After dinner, transfer to Ben Gurion Airport to be processed for our transatlantic return flight. Prepare to undergo top lengthy security before boarding!

Day 13: Saturday, June 24th: Shalom Jerusalem and Hello USA. (M, M). Board your flight, relax and enjoy onboard entertainment. You will be processed by U.S. Immigration and U.S. Customs at the first American port of entry.

Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. Participants should expect to walk at least 1 to 3 miles minimum in one day. Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

Roommate Assignments: Mater Dei Tours will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund. Mater Dei Tours cannot be held responsible if the roommate you were assigned to is not agreeable to you. If you desire to get your own room, you will be responsible for all the financial consequences of such action, including but not limited to, covering the single occupancy costs of both you and your ex-roommate.

Air Transportation: We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare and subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn, and/or upgrade with frequent flier miles for group bookings.

Airline Seating: Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions are advised to obtain Doctor's Orders so the airlines may have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. In addition to making the request through our company, please bring the doctor's note to the ticket counter.
