

Day 1: Wednesday, April 3rd, 2024: US Departure. (M)


Board your flight to Lisbon at Chicago O'Hare International Airport. Packaged airfare is included from Chicago, IL. Air transportation from other cities may be available for an add-on cost. Optional round-trip bus transportation is available from Marquette to Chicago, O'Hare.

Day 2: Thursday, April 4th: Arrival in Portugal; visit Santarém & Fatima. (M, D) Arrive in Lisboa (Lisbon), the Capital of Portugal. Depart for Fatima, but first stop in a small Portuguese town to witness the 13th century Eucharistic Miracle of Santarém. After a brief Eucharistic Adoration, Holy Mass* is celebrated here in a spirit of thanksgiving for a safe journey. Continue to Fatima and arrive at our hotel for check-in, dinner and our first night in Portugal. [Light Walking Day]









Day 3: Friday, April 5th: Fatima, Portugal. (B, L, D)

Wake up this morning at one of the world's holiest Marian Shrines, the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. This is the famous site where Our Lady appeared to 3 little shepherds in 1917. After breakfast, join us on the Hungarian Way of the Cross and visit the sites of the August 19th, 1917, Marian Apparition as well as the

and visit the sites of the Angel of Portugal. Also, visit the homes of St. Francisco and St. Jacinta (with a possibility of meeting relatives), as well as the home of Lucia's family. Join your group for lunch followed by shopping time. You may also opt to spend the whole day at the Fatima Shrine at leisure—with opportunity for Confession, Rosary, Way of the Cross, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and personal prayer time. Holy Mass* is celebrated at the Shrine in Fatima.

Tonight, join your new pilgrim family for



dinner. Afterwards, join pilgrims from all over the world while they pray the Holy Rosary at the Sanctuary grounds in a candlelight procession. [Moderate to Heavy Walking Day]

Day 4: Saturday, April 6th: Adeus Portugal! ¡Hola España! Alba de Tormes **& Avila, Spain.** (B, D) Depart Portugal for Spain this morning. If time allows, our first stop is by the old Roman Bridge of Salamanca, a wonderful photo spot of the beautiful Cathedral of Salamanca. After this brief stop, visit unforgettable Alba de Tormes, resting place of the incorrupt body of St. Teresa of Avila (and the place where she died). Holy Mass* celebrated here in Alba de Tormes. Afterwards. visit the museum to learn more about St. Teresa, the reformer of the Carmelite Order and first female Doctor of the Church. Then head south for the walled city of Avila, the birthplace of St. Teresa. Tonight, the famous medieval walls of Avila become very welcoming as we stay at a historic palace within the walls, close to the massive Cathedral of Avila. Enjoy a delicious dinner. [Light Walking Day]



Day 5: Sunday, April 7th: Avila. (B, D)

After a lovely breakfast, our first visit will be the Encarnación Monastery where she lived from 1535 to 1574. See her cell and the place where St. John of the Cross visited her as well as the confessional where St. John listened to her confessions. After this visit, enjoy a fascinating walking tour of Avila featuring the life of St. Teresa. Walk to the Convent of St. Joseph, her first foundation. Visit her home (now a church) and the place of her birth (now a chapel) and her Baptismal church, see one of the first schools she attended. In addition to the sites of St. Teresa, you will learn and see much of the historical city of Avila. Afterwards, those who wish can climb up the famous walls of Avila for a fascinating optional walking tour of Avila walls! This evening, enjoy dinner with the group. Afterwards, explore historic Avila at your leisure. Holy Mass* will be celebrated at one of the churches of Avila. [Heavy walking Day]



Day 6: Monday, April 8th: Segovia & Sigüenza, Spain. (B, D)



Before departing Avila stop by the "Cuatro Postes" (four posts), a famous spot in the life of young St. Teresa and a great panoramic spot to take a picture of medieval Avila and its famous city walls. Travel to historic Segovia. With its imposing Alcazar Castle, ancient Roman Aqueduct and historic Cathedral (the last gothic Cathedral in Spain), Segovia is one of the most captivating cities in Castilla and

one of UNESCO's patrimonies to humanity. Descend the promontory in a **rosary procession** until we reach the **Carmelite Convent and Church** which houses the remains of **St. John of the Cross**, co-reformer of the Carmelite Order. Afterwards, depart for the Province of Guadalajara, part of the autonomous community of Castilla-La Mancha, where we end the day with a nice dinner at our hotel. [Heavy Walking Day]

Day 7: Tuesday, April 9th: Zaragoza (Our Lady of the Pillar)

& Cataluña, Spain. (B, D) After breakfast, head northeast to the beautiful Capital of Aragon, Zaragoza (Saragossa). Our visit features the world famous Marian Shrine of the "Basilica de Nuestra Señora del Pilar" (Our Lady of the Pillar), where Our Blessed Mother appeared standing on top of a Pillar to the apostle St. James. It is reputed to be the first ever recorded apparition of Mary. This event happened while James was on his famous apostolic mission to Spain known as the "Camino de Santiago" (Road of St. James), one of the world's most famous pilgrimage routes. In the massive Plaza del Pilar, visit the chapel in the Basilica where the Pillar still stands. As a sign of fulfillment of your


pilgrimage to Our Lady of the Pillar, we will have the opportunity to practice the local custom of kissing the venerable column (or Pillar) where Our Lady once stood. Holy Mass* is celebrated at the Basilica/ Cathedral. Afterwards, depart for the proud autonomous community of Cataluña (Catalonia), Spain. Checkin to our hotel in the Barcelona area and enjoy dinner with your group. [Moderate Walking Day]







Day 8: Wednesday, April 10th: Monserrat, Manresa & Barcelona. (B, D) Drive to the bulbous mountain range on the outskirts of Barcelona to reach the Marian Monastery of Montserrat, a magnificent and historical Marian Shrine visited by many saints over the centuries, including St. Ignatius of Loyola himself. Nestled above the clouds of Cataluña at the Shrine of Montserrat houses the image of Our Lady of Montserrat above the Altar, to whom St. Ignatius surrendered his sword. Afterwards, continue to Manresa to visit the "Cova de Sant Ignasi" (the Cave of St. Ignatius), where St. Ignatius prayed for 10 months and wrote the famous spiritual exercises. Holy Mass* to be celebrated either in Manresa or Montserrat. This afternoon, travel back to Barcelona and enjoy a panoramic tour (from the bus) of the









Day 9: Thursday, April 11th: Adios España, Bon Jour La

France! Lourdes. (B, D) Depart Cataluña this morning heading towards Lourdes, France. After crossing the border into France, we continue to another one of the most famous Marian Shrines in the world, Our Lady of Lourdes. Upon arrival, we walk to the Shrine for Holy Mass* in one of the shrine's chapels. An orientation walk of the shrine's grounds follows. This evening, relax and freshen up for dinner at our hotel. After dinner, join pilgrims from around the world for the inspiring Rosary Torch **Procession**. [Light Walking Day]



Day 10: Friday, April 12th: Lourdes. (B, D) Enjoy a special day in Lourdes. Begin with Holy Mass* at the grotto (site of the apparitions -Mass* might be concelebrated with other English speaking Lourd

priests). Afterwards, you may opt for a personal day at leisure in Lourdes (time to go to the baths, participate in personal

devotions, etc.) or you may want to follow your escorts on an informal orientation walk of the Lourdes of St. Bernadette, including sites like the Mill, where St. Bernadette was born, and the "Cashot," where Bernadette's family lived. At 5:00 pm, there is a Eucharistic Procession with Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. After dinner join pilgrims from around the world for the inspiring Rosary torch procession at 9:00 pm. [Moderate to Heavy Walking Day]

Day 11: Saturday, April 13th: Paris, Lisieux. (B, D) Our memorable visit to Lourdes ends as we embark on the TGV (high speed train) from



Lourdes to Paris. In Paris, relax as we ride in our private coach to Lisieux, France, home of St. Therese of the Child Jesus, another Carmelite female Doctor of the Church (Church's youngest). Visit the magnificent Basilica of Sainte Therese with chapels representing different countries of the world. Its crypt is adorned with beautiful mosaics and on certain occasions, the relics of Saints

Louis and Zélie Martin (parents of St. Therese) are displayed here. After Mass, check-in at our hotel where we enjoy dinner with the group. [Light Walking Day]









Day 12: Sunday, April 14th: Lisieux & Omaha Beach. (B, D) After breakfast, walk to the Carmel of Lisieux.



where St. Therese lived from April 9, 1888 to September 30, 1897. She entered the Carmel as one of the youngest Carmelites ever, and died at the age of 24. In the Carmel, the tomb of St. Therese is adorned with a beautiful color statue depicting St. Therese at her death. Holy Mass* is celebrated here. Depart for the beaches of Normandy to see the D-Day Invasion Landing Beaches, where thousands of allied soldiers fought to liberate France from the evils of Nazism. Many brave soldiers lost their lives here so afterwards we visit the famous and impacting American Cemetery, with thousands of tombstones in perfect formation. As we walk by these tombstones, our group will pray a moving rosary for the souls of all the buried soldiers, and also for the protection of the many men and women in our Armed Forces, wherever they are in the world. After our unforgettable visit, return to Lisieux to visit Les Buissonnets, the house of Saints Louis and Zelie Martin where Therese lived 11 years of her life. The house is preserved as if the Martins were still living there. If time allows, see St. Peter's Cathedral of Lisieux, which still conserves the confessional used by St. Therese for her first confession. The Cathedral has a very interesting history dating back to the year 1149. Meet your group for dinner at our hotel. [Moderate to Heavy Walking Day]

Day 13: Monday, April 15th: Paris, France. (B. D) After breakfast, depart Lisieux for Paris, Capital of France. Enjoy a panoramic driven tour

(from the bus) with sights like the Eiffel Tower, the Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees, the Siene River, its famous bridges, Place de la Concorde and more (if reconstruction efforts and traffic allow, we may have a chance of a glimpse at Notre Dame Cathedral). The highlight of our visit is the Chapel of the Miraculous

Medal, where Our Lady appeared to St. Catherine Laboure (the Saint's incorrupt body is in the same chapel). Then, visit St. Vincent De Paul's remains at a chapel nearby. Holy Mass* is celebrated at one of the churches of Paris. Tonight, climb



Montmartre (Hill of Martyrs) while praying the rosary. Once there, enjoy a brief time for Eucharistic Adoration* at the Sacre Coeur (Sacred Heart) Basilica (*if available). Join your fellow pilgrims for a memorable dinner in Montmartre. Check into our Paris Hotel and pack for our return

flight. [Long day and moderate walking except for stair climbing of Mont Martre (elevator optional for a fee)]. [Moderate to Heavy Walking Day]



Start this day in Paris with more panoramic sightseeing from the bus, including a peek at the legendary Cathedral of Paris, Notre Dame (Our Lady of Paris). All experts agree that this Cathedral was the epitome of a Gothic Masterpiece! Afterwards, prepare to visit what is arguably the world's most famous art museum! The Louvre! Here you will have time to explore on your own some of the world's greatest art masterpieces, like the **Mona Lisa**. A big surprise to most people who visit the Louvre, is that this museum houses some of the World's best collections of religious art! For archeology buffs, Le Louvre also houses amazing treasures of humanity's history! Farewell Holy Mass* requested at Chapelle de Picpus (Sanctuaire Notre-Dame de Paix et Saint-Michel) next to the cemetery that houses the remains of the Carmelite Martyrs. This evening, join the group for an unforgettable farewell dinner, reminiscing all our moments experienced

Day 15: Wednesday, April 17th: Return to USA. (B, M) Transfer to the airport to board your homebound flight. As your plane takes off, take one last look out the window at the unique landscape of these beautiful lands and say:

Au Revoir France! ¡Adios España! Adeus Portugal!

All Masses are subject to approval from local ecclesiastical authorities.

Upon arrival, you will be processed by U.S. Homeland Security. Welcome Home!

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (you) acknowledges that Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. (d.b.a. = doing business as Mater Dei Tours and Relevant Journeys) is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Mater Dei Tours, such as air transportation, hotel accommodations, ground and sea transportations, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Mater Dei Tours and any religious or private organization contracting its services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions omissions, or conditions outside their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks, and is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against them. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company, acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers.

Deposits: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure your space to Mater Dei Tours. Your deposits are used to cover and guarantee your space. **Deposits will be refunded in the event the tour does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible.** If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due, Mater Dei Tours is authorized to charge the penalties to the credit card listed on the registration.

Final Payments: Full payment must be made no later than 100 days prior to departure unless otherwise stated. Payments may be made by check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. If payment is not received as scheduled, your reservation may be automatically canceled and your deposit payment is forfeited. If you use a credit card as payment, for your convenience, you may opt to have Mater Dei Tours charge your balance to the same authorized credit card on the registration form by simply calling us with your verbal authorization.

Tour Membership: To ensure a positive experience, Mater Dei Tours reserves the right to reject any client (before or during the trip at the expense of the traveler) whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. Participants should expect to walk at least 1 to 3 miles minimum in one day. Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

Roommate Assignments: Mater Dei Tours will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund. Mater Dei Tours cannot be held responsible if the roommate you were assigned to is not agreeable to you. If you desire to get your own room, you will be responsible for all the financial consequences of such action, including but not limited to, covering the single occupancy costs of both you and your ex-roommate.

Air Transportation: We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare and subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn, and/or upgrade with frequent flier miles for group bookings.

Airline Seating: Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions are advised to obtain Doctor's Orders so the airlines may have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. In addition to making the request through our company, please bring the doctor's note to the ticket counter. Passengers who desire a specific non-medical related seat are requested to contact the airline directly, approximately 30 days prior to departure for preferred seating. Group seating is under control of the airline and Mater Dei Tours can only pass on your requests.

Voluntary changes to itinerary: Independent voluntary changes to an individual passenger's itinerary are usually not permitted by most of our tour suppliers. Some exceptions may be granted in a case-by-case basis. All change requests must be made prior to 45 days before departure. If passenger purchased a land only package, they are free to plan their own itinerary before or after the trip (read Land Only bookings for restrictions).

Not Included: All items of a personal nature (room service, beverages, telephone charges, laundry, etc) and meals not specified on the tour itinerary are not included and must be paid by the passenger.

Accommodations and Itinerary: Land arrangements are provided as described in the tour program. The tour company reserves the right to change or substitute (1) hotels for accommodations in similar categories (2) or features of the itinerary in order to accommodate changes in the schedule.

Meals: Meals are provided as specified in the tour program. If you require special meals due to medical dietary restrictions, we must receive written details of your requirements at the time of booking. We cannot guarantee that each and every vendor will honor your requested diet, but every effort will be made to report and accommodate these requests. No weight loss plans or special nutrition diets can be accommodated.

Passports: Obtaining a passport is the sole responsibility of the passenger. Passports must be current and valid beyond the dates of travel. Your airline ticket name must match your passport name or you may be denied boarding the airplane. Passengers who are denied boarding due to discrepancies between ticket and passport names or because of expired passports accept full responsibility and are subject to the cancellation terms of the tour. Some countries, such as Israel, require that your passport expiration be 6 months beyond your travel dates. We recommend that you apply for your passports (if needed) no later than 3 months before departure.

Tips: Gratuities for baggage, hotel and restaurants detailed in the itinerary are included. **Gratuities for Tour Guide and Motor-coach Driver are NOT included** (unless otherwise stated in the brochure). Please read your "Essential Reading Material" (provided with your documents) for recommendations on tipping Please budget accordingly.

Smoking: Smoking is not allowed on the motor-coach but frequent stops are made throughout the day.

Travel Health: This pilgrimage is being operated under the premise that it is safe to travel under the current health protocols. If governmental authorities and/or our tour vendors, declare that it is no longer safe to travel because of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), Mater Dei will need to cancel the pilgrimage. If all our vendors cancel their services, Mater Dei will issue a full refund to all. If a passenger cancels because of fear of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), but authorities still declare that it is safe to travel as long as people practice the appropriate advice to keep proper hygiene to avoid contamination, the passenger shall be assessed the appropriate cancellation penalty detailed in the first column. Please consider bringing a face mask (may be required by some airlines and/or foreign governments), especially if you are coughing and sneezing. If you are sick with Covid-19 or any other sickness, please stay home.

Total Group Cancellation: If it becomes necessary to cancel an entire tour prior to departure, Mater Dei Tours will offer the next available date or will make a full refund of money paid as soon as all our vendors refund us your money. Mater Dei Tours cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs, fees or cancellation penalties relating to any independent non-refundable purchases (personal airfares, travel insurance, etc.).
